



EVENT NOTICE: St David's Hospice Conwy Half Marathon Sunday 17th November 2024

Dear Local Resident/Business

We are writing to you as a resident / business within Conwy/Deganwy/Llandudno to let you know about the forthcoming 16th Conwy Half Marathon event. This will take place on Sunday 17th November 2024 starting at 09.30am on the quayside in Conwy.

The half marathon is a great boost to the local economy and is a firm fixture in the events calendar for the area with our partner charity St David's Hospice.

The race provides a fantastic opportunity for everyday people to challenge themselves and raise many thousands of pounds for charitable causes.

We wanted to let you know that runners will be passing through your area between the approximate times set out below.

It would be great if you could come out and cheer on the runners, it really is a challenge for some and your encouragement can make all the difference.

Residents are asked to be aware of runners and the lead cyclists along these roads and to proceed with caution, for safety's sake.

There is also a Fun Run open to everyone along the Conwy Cob approx 1 mile starting at 08.45, this can be entered on the day from 7.30am. (we do ask for children aged 9 and under to be accompanied by an adult).

Road Closures

If the route passes outside your home or business, we would kindly like to ask you to avoid parking on the street where possible, should you need to use your vehicle during the event, we would be grateful if you could park your vehicle on the opposite side to the runners.

The road closure notice is from 6:30am – 3pm to allow the traffic management company to **SAFELY** set up and remove their signage and cones.

However, we only **approximately** expect the runners to be using the roads for the period of time set out below, please use this as a guide.

8.30am-10.15am, Full closure, Conwy Road, Conwy (the cob) & will reopen as a one way out of Conwy from 10.15am, please use the A55 Conwy tunnel to access Conwy town. This will be fully re-open by latest 3pm

9.30am – 10am, The main big roundabout by Lidl through to the mini roundabout at the bottom of St Georges drive.

The entrance to Lidl will be open for 10am, please use the main entrance to access Lidl as runners will be using Glan y Mor road by the rear of the store.

9.30am – 1pm Glan Y Mor Road, Llandudno Junction

9.30am – 1pm A546 from the mini roundabout at the bottom of St Georges drive through to Deganwy village.

9.30am – 1pm Deganwy Quay, traffic management operatives will be allowing access to and from the Quay when safe to do so, however, please expect some delays. For Deganwy village, please use the coast road from Llandudno.

9.30am – 12.30pm Maesdu Road, Bryniau Rd, Gloddaeth Avenue (from the roundabout to the Lilly hotel) Right onto West Parade.

9.30am – 11.30am Abbey road, up Church walks past Ysgol San Sior, then down Church walks towards the pier, going past the top of Mostyn street (Empire hotel).

9.50am – 11.30am North parade from Church walks and past the Grand hotel and on to Marine drive.

Traffic management operatives will be allowing access for residents and businesses when safe to do so, however, please expect some delays.

9.50am– 12pm Marine drive, toll gate to toll gate.

The A546 coast road from Llandudno will be unaffected, but delays are expected. Please use an alternative route where possible

Roads will be reopened on a rolling basis as runners go through each section closed off, all roads will be re-opened by 3pm.

The runners have a cut off time and a maximum time of 15 minutes per mile allowed, after this they are instructed by the marshals to continue as a pedestrian along the pavements.

Delays are expected but access will be provided for all residents and businesses when it is safe to do so, emergency services access will be maintained at all times.

As the organisers, we would like to apologise in advance for any inconvenience that this may cause and ask for your patience whilst the event is in progress. We hope you agree that this will be a great event for the local area.

Thank you for your cooperation, the support of the community will help us to ensure that we host an event that all our visitors will enjoy.
